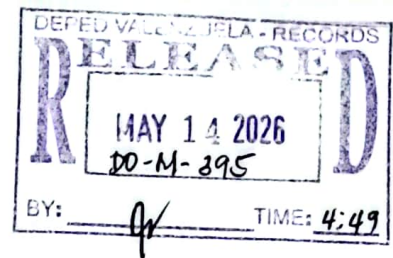

1. This Office announces the acceptance of applications for the positions of:

2. Interested applicants must meet the Qualification Standards (QS) for the above-mentioned positions pursuant to DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2025, **“Amended QS for Teacher I-III, Master Teacher I-IV, and School Principal I-IV positions and the QS for newly created Teacher IV-VII and Master Teacher V positions”**. Likewise, qualified applicants must meet the Performance Requirements as specified in Item No. 25 of DepEd Order No. 20, s. 2024 as amended by DepEd Order 34, s. 2025.

3. External applicants, such as college instructors and private school teachers may apply, provided they meet the qualifications and performance requirements of the positions based on DO 20, s. 2024 and DO 19, s. 2025.

Thus, no additional or new documents will be considered during the evaluation/assessment and deliberation process except for those determined by the HRMPSB that are needed for verification and validation of the initially submitted documents.

7. Applicants assume full responsibility and accountability for the authenticity and veracity of the documents submitted, as evidenced by the Omnibus Sworn Statement (Annex A), duly signed by the applicant and notarized by an authorized official. Any false and fraudulent document submitted shall be grounds for disqualification.

8. It is understood that applicants are willing to be transferred to schools where vacancies exist.

9. DepEd Order No. 20, s. 2024 titled "*Guidelines on the Recruitment, Selection, and Appointment to Higher Teaching Positions*" shall be the basis of evaluation and assessment.
