The City Health Office sincerely acknowledges and appreciates the Department of Education's steadfast commitment to safeguarding the health and well-being of both teaching and non-teaching personnel.


In line with this, we respectfully request that your teaching personnel be instructed to visit the nearest health center **from 1:00 p.m. onwards** for the issuance of medical clearance as part of their annual medical evaluation. This schedule will ensure that they do not mix with our predominantly sick patients who frequently seek medical attention during the morning hours.

To further facilitate a fast and efficient evaluation process, we kindly ask that each teacher bring their individual laboratory and diagnostic results when seeking certification. This will enable our physicians to properly assess their health status and, if cleared, the City Health Office is prepared to issue their medical certificates on the same day.

We also wish to reiterate that, at present, laboratory testing at the Main Medical Laboratory cannot be accommodated, as the facility is prioritizing services for sick patients.

We look forward to strengthening our collaboration with your office in addressing the health concerns of your personnel and ensuring their continued well-being.
