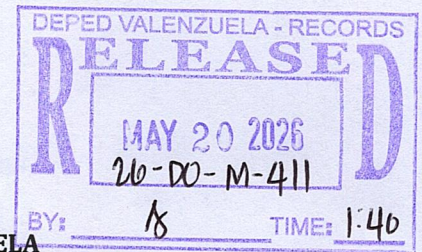

Greetings from DSWD-NCR!

This has reference to the annual Supply Side Assessment (SSA), which evaluates the availability, accessibility, adequacy, and condition of health and education facilities in 4Ps communities. Data from the assessment, validated by local health and education heads, are presented to the City/Municipal Advisory Council (C/MAC) to guide coordinated interventions that support beneficiaries in meeting their health, education, and Family Development Session (FDS) requirements


However, the current SSA tool has limitations, as it does not sufficiently link findings to actual compliance or address critical issues such as "Not Attending School" (NAS) and "Not Availing Services for Health" (NASH) cases. Consequently, the Field Office-NCR, through the Regional Program Management Office (RPMO), recognizes the need for a modernized, data-driven SSA checklist to support LGUs, Health, and Education sectors in planning targeted interventions and enhancing outcomes for 4Ps beneficiaries.

Relative to this, we would like to inform the School Division Offices, specifically the School Principals in NCR, that the Program will carry out a validation using the enhanced SSA checklist, focusing on social services related to the compliance of 4Ps beneficiaries to health conditions. This will tentatively start from April 1, 2026 and will last until the end of May 2026

Greetings from DSWD-NCRI!

This letter serves as a formal follow-through regarding the representation of the Department of Education (DepEd) – NCR in the 4Ps Regional Advisory Council (RAC).

During our most recent quarterly meeting held last February 27, 2026, member agencies reaffirmed their collective commitment to regular attendance to ensure the smooth implementation of the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program. We regret to note, however, that DepEd-NCR was once again unable to send a representative to this session.

Our records indicate that DepEd's last active participation was in September 2024. Having missed all scheduled meetings in 2025 and the first quarter of 2026, there is an urgent need to reconnect. As the 4Ps is a data-driven program, the active participation of core implementing agencies—particularly DepEd—is vital to align information systems and fulfill the conditions of the Conditional Cash Transfer (CCT).

To ensure your office is updated, we would like to request again a virtual meeting together with the 18 School Division Offices in NCR and RAC Focal Persons on May 11, 2026, Monday at 2 PM onwards to reiterate the pending discussions and critical recommendations from the 2024–2025 sessions that require DepEd's immediate actions. Below are the proposed agenda:

- **System Integration:** Directive for the DepEd-PPRD Team and SDO Planning Officers to develop a project and monitoring plan that synchronizes the 4Ps Information System (4PsIS) with the Learner Information System (LIS) / EBEIS prior to the opening of SY 2025–2026.
- **Learning Recovery:** Implementation of a catch-up plan specifically for 4Ps learners at risk of dropping out (SARDOS), utilizing the agency's Learning Recovery Program.
- **Employment Support:** Establishment of interim guidelines for the endorsement and placement of 4Ps beneficiaries who have successfully passed the Licensure Examination for Teachers (LET).

- **Youth Development:** Strengthening youth formation by aligning school-based programs with 4Ps Youth Development Sessions (YDS).
- **Accountability:** Regular monitoring and reporting of accomplishments as outlined in the 4Ps Regional Convergence Plan (RCP).

The success of the 4Ps in the National Capital Region relies heavily on the convergence of our efforts. Attached is the copy of the minutes for the February 27 meeting for your review. We look forward to your favorable response and your renewed presence in our future Council proceedings. Ms. April Joyce C.
