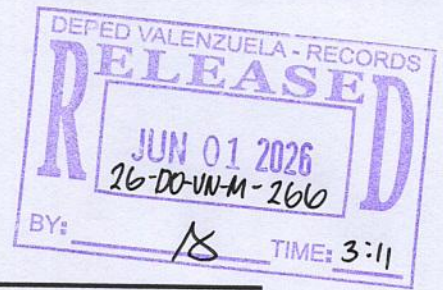

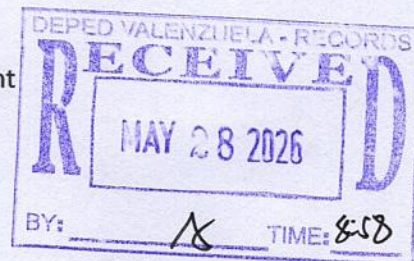

 - o Large bags


Participation in this activity is highly encouraged as it strengthens patriotism, appreciation of Philippine history, and active citizenship among our Girl Scouts and adult leaders.
