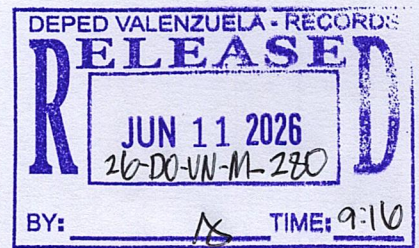

3. You may conduct this seminar during the End-of-Term Block in September, pursuant to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026, titled "Implementing Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education," to ensure that it will not disrupt the instructional block.
4. The parties will be accountable for the protection of all personnel involved.
5. No Collection Policy; and
6. No school funds shall be utilized.

For monitoring purposes, the school shall furnish the Office of detailed activities.

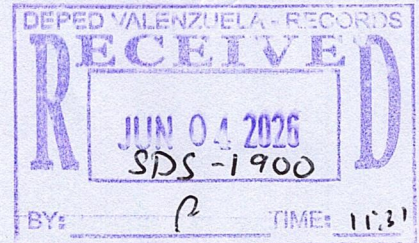
