



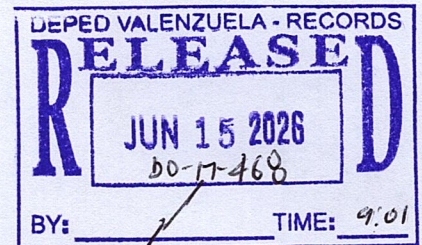

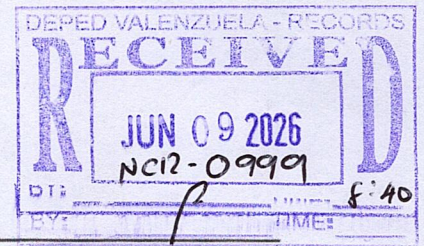

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) recognizes the vital role of guided reading activities in cultivating a love for reading and strengthening comprehension skills among young learners. As part of its continuing efforts to promote reading, DepEd has provided two (2) storybooks to all Key Stage 1 (Kindergarten to Grade 3) learners. These titles include Filipino-, English-, and Dual-language storybooks by various publishers. These storybooks were donated and are not for resale. Reproduction and distribution were made possible under the rights granted by the respective publishers, authorizing DepEd to reproduce a specified number of copies.

2. The titles are as follows:

Kindergarten:

Grade 3:

- a. *Ang Bayang Maaksaya sa Tubig* by Samira Saidani, Shaymaa Sobhi (The Asia Foundation)
- b. *Ang Masisipag na Langgam* (Rex Book Store, Inc.)

3. To support effective reading instruction and facilitate meaningful reading experiences, DepEd issues Guide Questions for Key Stage 1 (Kindergarten to Grade 3) storybooks for use by teachers, with librarians and learning resource supervisors supporting the management and access to learning materials.
4. The guide questions are intended to support guided reading sessions for learners. The questions are organized by storybook title and are categorized into pre-reading, during-reading, and post-reading phases to promote deeper engagement and critical thinking.
