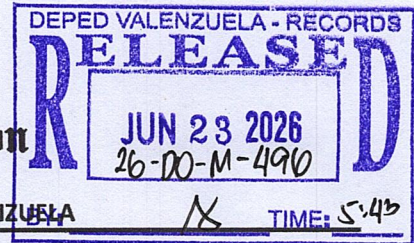

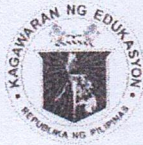

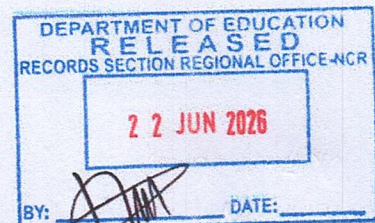

**REITERATION ON THE GUIDELINES FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF INCENTIVES
FOR STUDENT-ATHLETES THROUGH ELECTRONIC WALLET**

1. This is in reference to Office Memorandum **OM-OUGOPS-2026-05-01893** dated June 9, 2026, from the Office of the Undersecretary for Governance and Operations, entitled "*Reiteration on the Guidelines for the Distribution of Incentives for Student-Athletes through Electronic Wallet.*" In this regard, Schools Division Offices (SDOs) through Division Sports Officers are hereby directed to:

- a. Disseminate the attached guidelines to all concerned schools, athlete-medalists, parents, and legal guardians;
- b. Inform all qualified athlete-medalists regarding the requirements and procedures for the release of incentives through Maya;
- c. Collect and validate the following information:
 - Maya Account Name and Account Number of athlete-medalists with existing Maya accounts; or
 - Maya Account Name and Account Number of parents or legal guardians of athlete-medalists who do not have Maya accounts;
- d. Consolidate and endorse the validated list of qualified athlete-medalists and their corresponding Maya account details to the Regional Office - ESSD, using the attached template, and submit to this link: <https://tinyurl.com/NCRMEDALISTATHLETES-MAYA> for subsequent submission to the Palarong Pambansa Secretariat and the Philippine Sports Commission.

2. Pursuant to the attached PSC Advisory dated 31 May 2026, the incentive amounts are as follows:

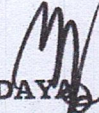

In relation to the recently concluded **2026 Palarong Pambansa** held in **Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur**, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Office of the Undersecretary for Governance and Operations and in coordination with the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), hereby reiterates the following guidelines on the release of incentives to eligible student-athlete medalists.

In line with the government's continuing efforts to promote digital transformation in public service delivery, incentives for qualified athlete-medalists shall be released through their registered **Maya Account**, a secure digital payment platform. This initiative aims to ensure the efficient, transparent, and timely distribution of incentives while minimizing administrative delays and facilitating a more streamlined disbursement process.

DepEd and PSC recognize the remarkable achievements of our student-athletes and remain committed to ensuring that their well-deserved incentives are delivered in a secure and convenient manner. In this regard, the support and cooperation of all Regional Heads of Delegation (HODs) are hereby enjoined in the implementation of these guidelines.

To ensure the accurate and timely release of incentives to all qualified athlete-medalists, all Regional Heads of Delegation are hereby directed to refer to and comply with the **Philippine Sports Commission Advisory dated 31 May 2026 on the Guidelines for the Distribution of Incentives for Medalist-Athletes**, which is attached to this Memorandum for guidance and appropriate action.

We are pleased to inform all participating delegations of the 2026 Palarong Pambansa that incentives for eligible athlete-medalists shall be released digitally through **MAYA**, in support of the government's thrust to digitize financial transactions and ensure a more transparent, secure, and efficient system of disbursement.

More than a procedural undertaking, this initiative ensures that the well-deserved incentives of our young champions are delivered with utmost efficiency, security, and timeliness.

We respectfully call upon the steadfast support and cooperation of all **Regional Heads of Delegations (HODs)** in the implementation of these **Guidelines** for all Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medalists.

I. INCENTIVE AMOUNTS

To recognize the achievements of athletes in the 2026 Palarong Pambansa, incentive amounts are provided based on their performance in either team or individual sports:

Team Sports (*awarded per member*)

Gold Medalists: ₱3,000

Silver Medalists: ₱2,000

Bronze Medalists: ₱1,000

Individual Sports

Gold Medalists: ₱5,000

Silver Medalists: ₱3,000

Bronze Medalists: ₱2,000

Athletic Record Broken (Measurable by Time and Distance): ₱5,000

II. COVERAGE

These incentives cover **only Palarong Pambansa athletes participating in regular and para sports**. Medalists from demonstration sports, exhibition sports, and similar events or activities are not covered under this program.

III. MAYA ACCOUNT SUBMISSION

All incentives shall be coursed through the nominated and validated Maya accounts of athlete-medalists. In cases where Palarong Pambansa athlete-medalists do not have Maya accounts, their parents or legal guardians may provide the corresponding account name and account number on their behalf.

In line with the above, we respectfully seek the assistance of all Regional HODs in carrying out the following duties:

- *Inform* all Palarong Pambansa athlete-medalists and their parents or legal guardians about these Guidelines;
- *Collect* and validate the **Account Names** and **Maya Account Numbers** of
 - athlete-medalists with existing Maya accounts;
 - parents or legal guardians of athlete-medalists without Maya accounts.
- *Endorse* the list to the **2026 PPS** for validation and processing.

III. DISTRIBUTION

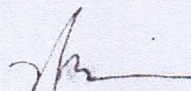
1. The 2026 Palarong Pambansa Secretariat (PPS) shall transmit the validated lists from Regional HODs to the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC).
2. Upon approval by PSC officials, the corresponding incentives shall be directly credited to the Maya accounts provided by the 2026 PPS.

VI. COORDINATION AND SUPPORT

Concerns regarding these Guidelines may be sought through the 2026 PPS.

We sincerely appreciate your continued cooperation and commitment in ensuring the smooth implementation of this initiative and the successful conduct of the 2026 Palarong Pambansa.
