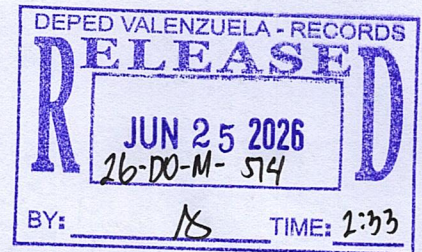

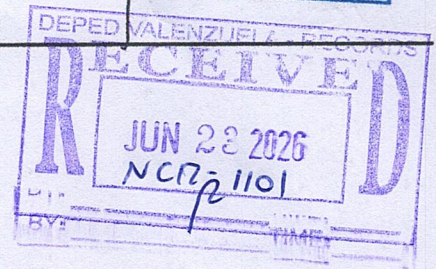
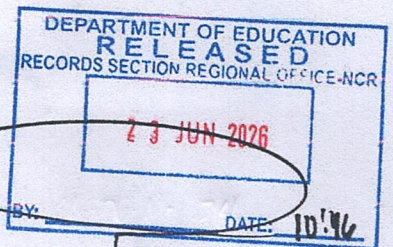

SUBJECT : **INVITATION ON THE POLO FLAG FOOTBALL LEAGUE (PFFL) YOUTH SPORTS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM**

DATE : 19 June 2026

1. Attached is a communication from the Polo Flag Football League (PFFL) requesting support for the promotion and conduct of Flag Football orientation sessions, introductory clinics, training programs, and youth sports development activities in public secondary schools within the National Capital Region.

2. PFFL is a youth-centered sports organization registered under the Youth Organization Registration Program (YORP) of the National Youth Commission. The organization aims to promote Flag Football, a non-contact team sport that develops physical fitness, teamwork, discipline, leadership, sportsmanship, and strategic thinking among learners. Their proposed activities include:

- Introductory Flag Football Clinics and Demonstrations;
- Student-Athlete Development Sessions; and
- Inter-School Friendly Games and Competitions.

3. The request of PFFL is for the information and appropriate consideration of interested schools, subject to existing DepEd policies, child protection standards, safety protocols, and the approval of the concerned Schools Division Office and school authorities.

4. Participation of schools and learners shall be strictly voluntary and shall not disrupt regular classes and other mandated school activities. No DepEd funds shall be utilized unless otherwise authorized and in accordance with applicable rules and regulations.
