



Dear Sir,

Greetings!

In view of the rising dengue cases recorded in the previous year, and based on data indicating a potential increase in cases as early as the first quarter of the year, the City Health Office, in support of the City Government's intensified Dengue Prevention and Control Program, will conduct misting operations in schools. This initiative serves as a proactive preventive measure aimed at reducing mosquito breeding sites and curbing the spread of dengue, particularly in high-population settings such as educational institutions.

Moreover, as the previous epidemiological data suggests that majority of Dengue Fever cases are school-aged children, we are furthering our interventions to curb this anticipated increase giving emphasis on the conduct of effective mosquito vector control measures which include regular clean-up drive activities (Search and Destroy) and practicing the 4S strategies ensuring that the full circle of interventions is executed. And among this is the conduct of space spraying to prevent vector to human contact by reducing the adult mosquito population.

Relative thereto, recognizing its importance we would like to inform you that we will be conducting the school-based space spraying **on all Saturdays of the months of January to March 2026: starting January 17, 2026.** This will be conducted before the classes reopen to prevent classes interruption and ensure the safety of the operations following the schedules below:



Moreover, we are humbly asking your assistance in disseminating the schedules of the space spraying operations and **be prioritized in every school calendars**. Here are the **guidelines for the pre and post space spraying operations that MUST BE STRICTLY COMPLIED:**

A. Pre-space spraying:

- a. Ensure that the mosquito breeding sites are eliminated such as not but limited to:
 - i. Used tires
 - ii. Clogged canals
 - iii. Clogged roof gutters and water spouts
 - iv. Unused water containers with longstanding stagnant water
 - v. Improper waste disposals
 - vi. Flower vases and pot bottom plates for ornamental plants
- b. Ensure that the school has no ongoing activities during the operation.
- c. Ensure that windows and doors of the schools are open.
- d. Turn-off air-conditioning units, water sprinklers and smoke detectors.
- e. Keep unauthorized personnel away from the operation.
- f. Designate a school point person to guide the Vector Control Team during the conduct of the operation.

B. Post- space spraying:

- a. Allow 45 minutes – 1 hour before reoccupying the sprayed areas.
- b. Mop and sweep the floor.
- c. Wipe the surfaces as necessary.

C. Cancellation and rescheduling


- a. If in any situation, the school will opt to cancel the operation, the **school is requested to send a letter of notification to the City Health Office indicating the reason of cancellation 3 days before the operation.** Otherwise, the operation will push through.
- b. **Rescheduling:** Any cancelled misting operations shall be rescheduled only after the completion of all the school's operation.

This initiative will be closely supervised, monitored and evaluated by the office.
