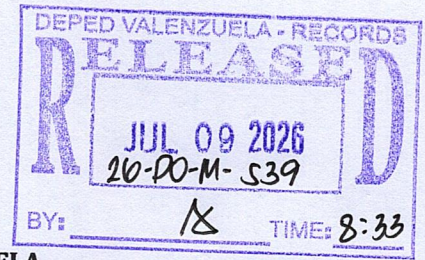

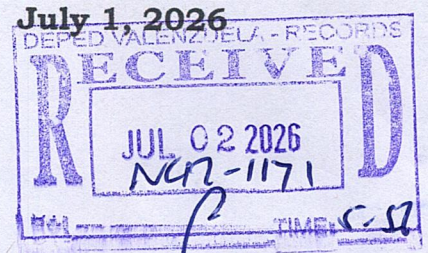
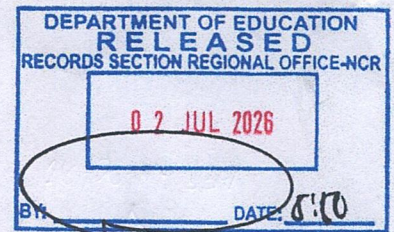

**REGIONAL MONITORING OF SCHOOLS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026**

**To:** Schools Division Superintendents  
Assistant Schools Division Superintendents  
Regional Functional Division Chiefs

1. Pursuant to the Department of Education's mandate to ensure quality basic education through governance, quality assurance, monitoring, and technical assistance under existing DepEd policies and issuances, the Department of Education – National Capital Region (DepEd NCR) shall conduct the Regional Monitoring of Schools for Calendar Year 2026 to assess the implementation of DepEd policies, standards, and programs that promote quality learning, safe and inclusive learning environments, and effective school governance.
2. The Regional Monitoring aims to:
  - a) monitor the implementation of DepEd policies, standards, programs, and quality assurance requirements;
  - b) assess the effectiveness of school programs, projects, and activities;
  - c) provide timely, evidence-based technical assistance and coaching to address identified gaps;
  - d) identify strengths, good practices, operational gaps, and priority areas for improvement;
  - e) generate evidence to support policy enhancement, planning, decision-making, and resource allocation; and
  - f) strengthen accountability, good governance, and continuous improvement to enhance school performance and learner outcomes.
3. The monitoring shall use the approved Regional School Monitoring Tool to ensure consistency, objectivity, and fairness.

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4. Schools Division Offices shall facilitate coordination with schools and provide the necessary administrative support during the conduct of the monitoring.
5. Members of the Regional Monitoring Teams shall perform their duties with professionalism, impartiality, integrity, and adherence to applicable ethical standards. The monitoring shall be developmental in nature, emphasizing technical assistance and continuous school improvement.
6. The Regional Monitoring Teams shall submit a consolidated report to the Office of the Regional Director upon completion of the monitoring, highlighting key findings, good practices, identified gaps, and recommended interventions.
7. Attached to this Memorandum is the composition of the Regional Monitoring Teams for the information and guidance of all concerned. To preserve the integrity and objectivity of the monitoring process, monitoring visits shall be unannounced. Accordingly, the schedules and school assignments of the teams shall not be disclosed in advance.
8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are hereby directed.
