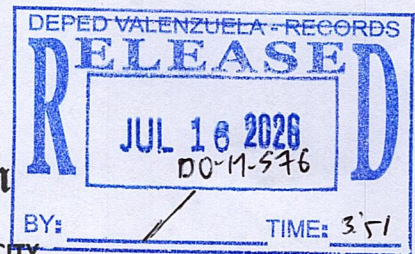

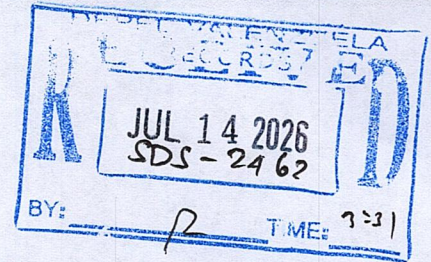

The seminar will feature discussions on the following health topics:

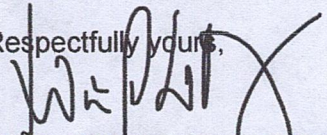
- * Scoliosis Awareness
