

5. DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2001 titled “Prohibition the Commercialization of the DECS Organization Through Endorsements and Accreditation of Goods and Services”; and
6. May only distribute flyers and brochures related to their programs and offerings; no other form of solicitation, marketing, or promotional activity shall be conducted.


