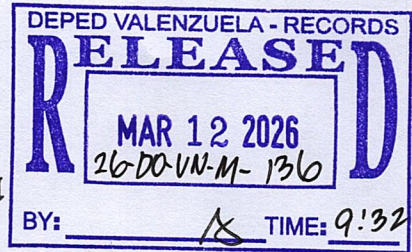

Particular attention is invited to paragraph nos. 3, 4, 5 and 6, for reference.

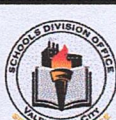

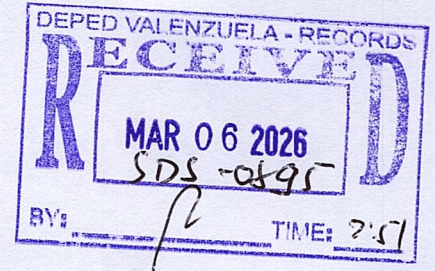

We respectfully write to express our intent to collaborate with the **Schools Division Office of Valenzuela City** in support of **Fire Prevention Month** initiatives and school safety preparedness programs.

**Alerto PH** is a disaster intelligence and early warning platform supported by the **Department of Science and Technology (DOST)**, focused on strengthening community-level preparedness through technology, awareness, and coordinated response.

As part of our Fire Prevention Month initiative, **we would like to request the opportunity to conduct an orientation and demonstration session with selected school principals to introduce the Alerto platform and our fire monitoring system.** The goal is to demonstrate how the technology supports early detection, reporting, and coordination during emergencies, and to identify one school that may serve as the initial pilot site.


For the pilot, we propose prioritizing schools that do not yet have a Fire Detection and Alarm System (FDAS) and currently rely mainly on portable fire extinguishers as part of their compliance with the Fire Code of the Philippines (**Republic Act 9514**). These typically include low-rise school buildings with one to two storeys.

As part of the pilot, the Schools Division Office will also be provided with a complimentary Alerto Command Center account, allowing your office to monitor safety alerts and incident reports from participating schools in real time.

When classes resume, **we would also be honored to support Brigada Eskwela activities** by assisting schools in conducting fire preparedness orientations and safety drills for students, teachers, and school personnel. **May we respectfully request a meeting at your convenience to discuss how these activities may align with the priorities and guidelines of your office.**

Thank you for your time and consideration. We look forward to the opportunity to collaborate with the Schools Division Office of Valenzuela City in promoting stronger fire safety awareness and preparedness in schools.
